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## SELF-REFLECTIVE QUESTIONS

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- What does diversity mean to you?
- What should diversity look like in ece?
- Looking at the three areas noted with "Understanding Diversity" which area do you think you are currently in?
- Why teach and promote diversity? Why the environment?
- We should be reflecting on what the classroom is saying/teaching to the children each day? How do they view themselves in a classroom?
- What are the current ways you promote diversity in your program?
- Are all children in your classroom represented?
- What voices speak in your classroom?
- Examine your current resources, tools and toys - does it form biases?
- Do you personally feel comfortable about the level of diversity in your program?
- Are there any current toys/materials available in your program? Is this a norm?
- How many books on the bookshelf currently promote diversity and/or inclusion? Count them
- Think about the family types within your classroom - are they represented in the program? What about the types not in the classroom, is there a way to represent that?
- What are areas you feel your classroom needs to improve on? What are your team's next steps?
